William Blake (1757 – 1827), English poet, painter and printmaker, is now considered a seminal figure in the history of poetry and the visual arts of the Romantic Age.

Following on from her successful lecture tour in northern Germany in September 2018, Dr. Erle will give a talk about Blake's reception in Germany. Touching on the main trends in the artistic and critical responses to Blake and his reception as a poet, painter and mystic in Germany in the 19th and 20th centuries, this talk will focus on the German-Jewish artist Ludwig Meidner (1884-1966), and conclude with an overview of the various literary, critical and artistic responses to Blake in the German-speaking countries.

We look forward to welcoming a large audience to this talk on one of the more important figures in British cultural history.
